(5) Take one of the following capstone courses: PSYC 485, PSYC 486, PSYC 487, PSYC 488, PSYC 490.

Capstone may be taken fall or spring of senior year.

(6) Select 18 units from the following: PSYC 311, PSYC 321, PSYC 322, PSYC 323, PSYC 324, PSYC 335, PSYC 337, PSYC 438.
Consult major advisor.

(7) Select 12 units from upper division breadth requirements. See psychology program description in the catalog. Some options also count toward UD GE D and GE E. If those options are not selected, take UD GE D and/or GE E in place of an elective course.

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
